Key Achievements

- 2,096 graduates
- 88.4% employment/startup rate among graduates
- 149 startups founded



Hanium Dream Up

- Korea's largest AI-ICT talent program
- Hanium Dream Up competition, startup mentoring, performance showcase, overseas training

Key Achievements

- 70,152 total mentees
- 20,287 projects completed
- 7,625 Total Mentors
- 77.3% mentee employment rate



ICT Internship Program

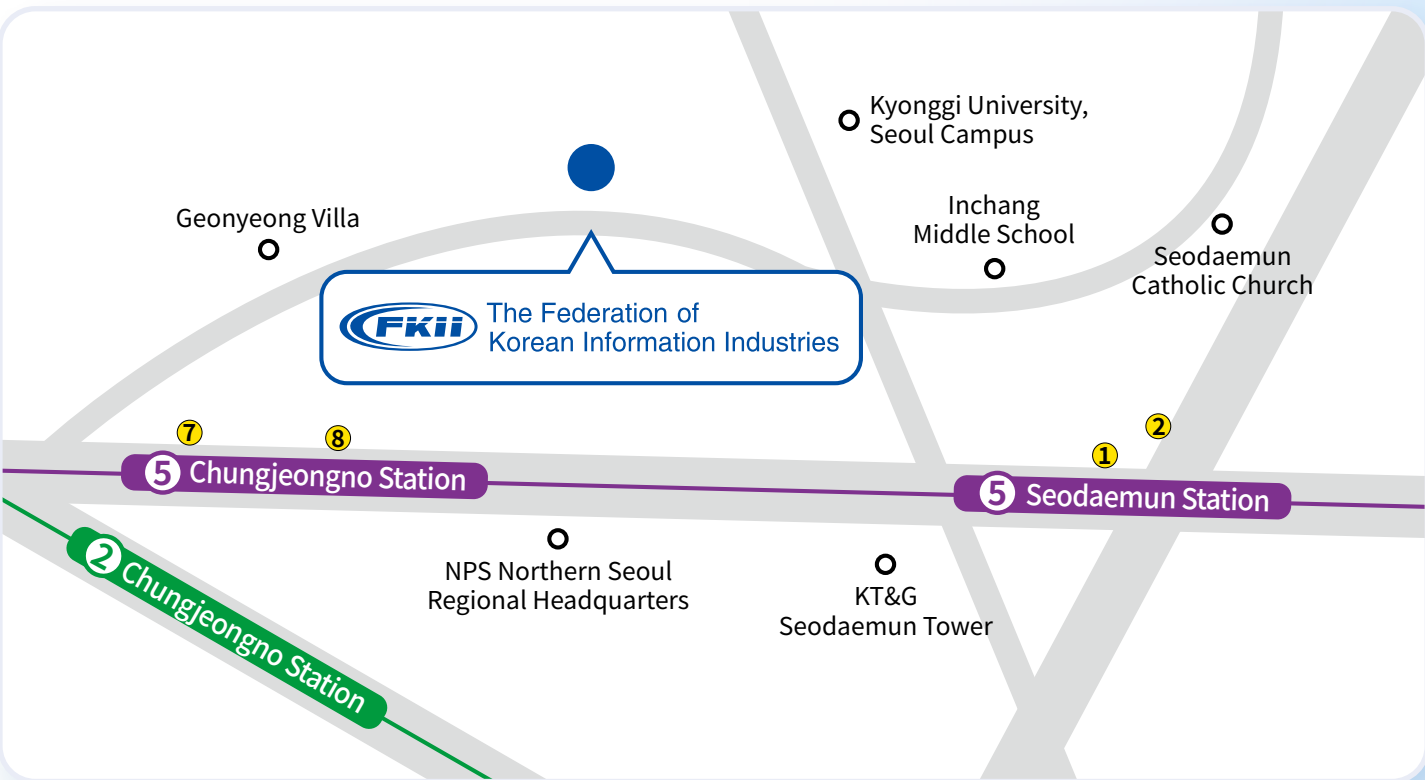
